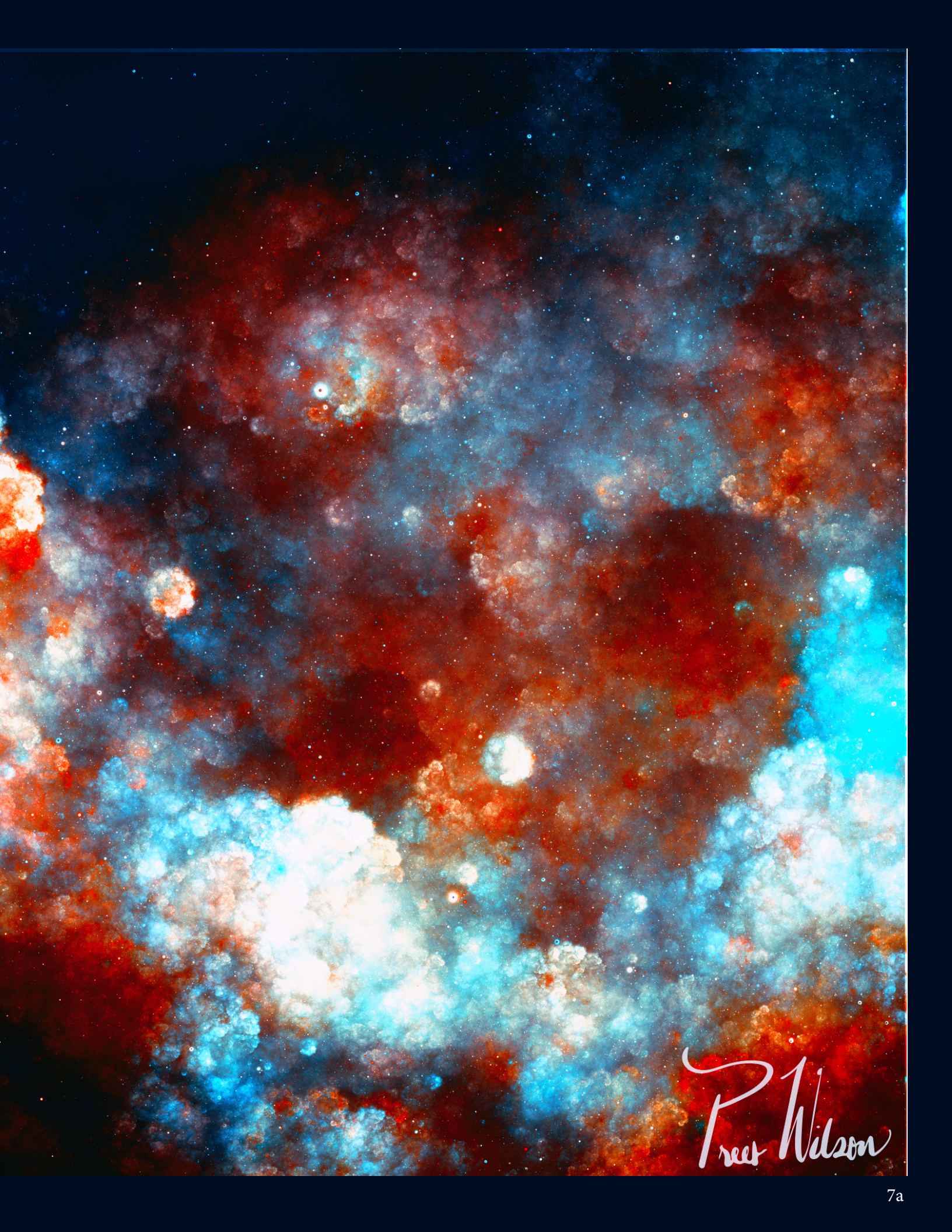




art.

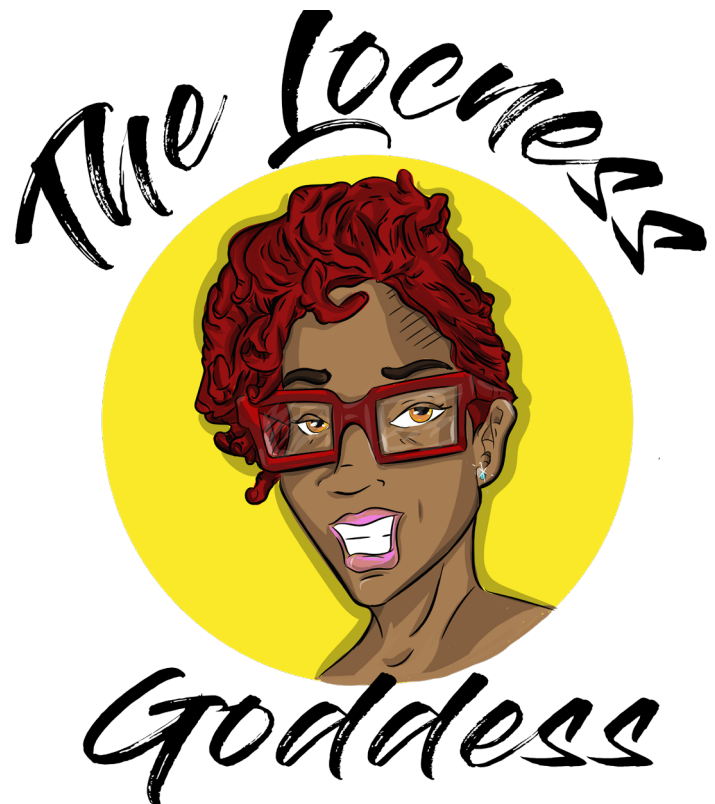
