Erin Hickey

Erin Hickey, an artist and double amputee lost both of her legs due to compartment syndrome due to a heroin overdose. Today and for the past two years she has been sober, free from any opiate. “While I was using,” said Hickey, “I always seek a fix, hurting my family with my absence, I can’t imagine the worry I caused them. I had sobered up for 2 years before I went out for the last time, and this time I fell unconscious for 12 hours. I was put into a medically induced coma for 4 weeks. I’ll never forget the surgeon’s face when I woke up he said “Erin if you want to live you have to lose your legs.” It felt

like a nightmare. This can't be real! I thought long and hard for weeks about what to do, should I let myself go septic and die. Would my year old baby be better off without a junkie mother like me? Finally a friend who I can only describe as an

angel came to me and said your son deserves his mother in his life. That was the day I consented to the surgery.

Im grateful to be alive and to watch my son grow up and be a part of his life. I've struggled through homelessness immediately after my amputations for over a year. Today I have an apartment of my own, a steady job as a graphic designer and soon I'll be driving with hand controls. God took my legs because of my disease. God also gave them back in the form of microprocessor knees and every day I give thanks for the opportunity to live that so many people like myself did not have. I would love to encourage anyone who has or is struggling with drug addiction to see that they are worthy of happiness, fulfilling lives and that recovery is possible!

As an artist Ms Hickey's work revolves around mermaids, due to her affinity and respect for the ocean. "I loved to surf" Hickey states, "and when I lost my legs I thought that my life was ending, but I couldn't have been more wrong. I'm happy to say that I have swam in the ocean every summer since my amputations."

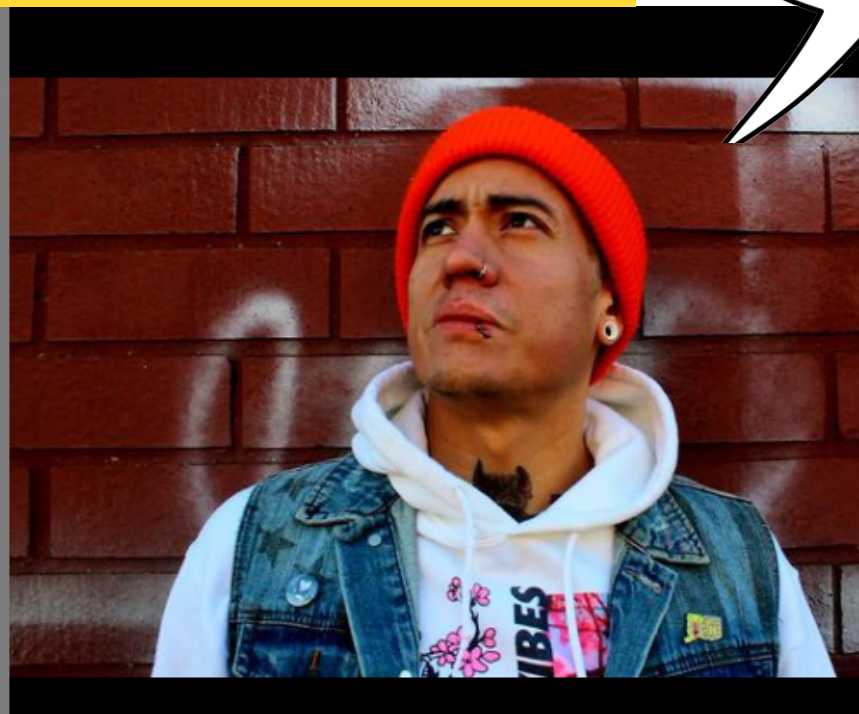

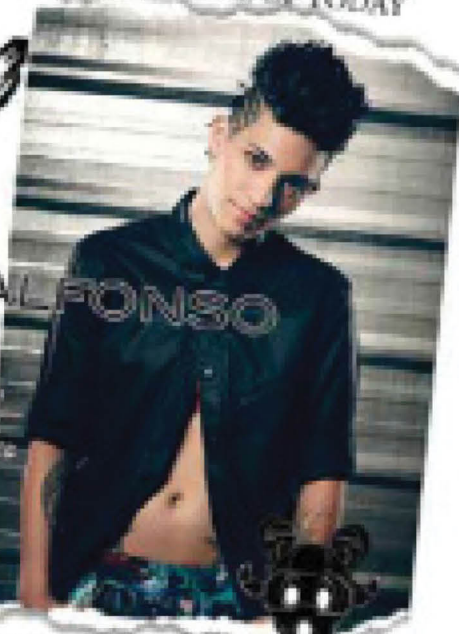

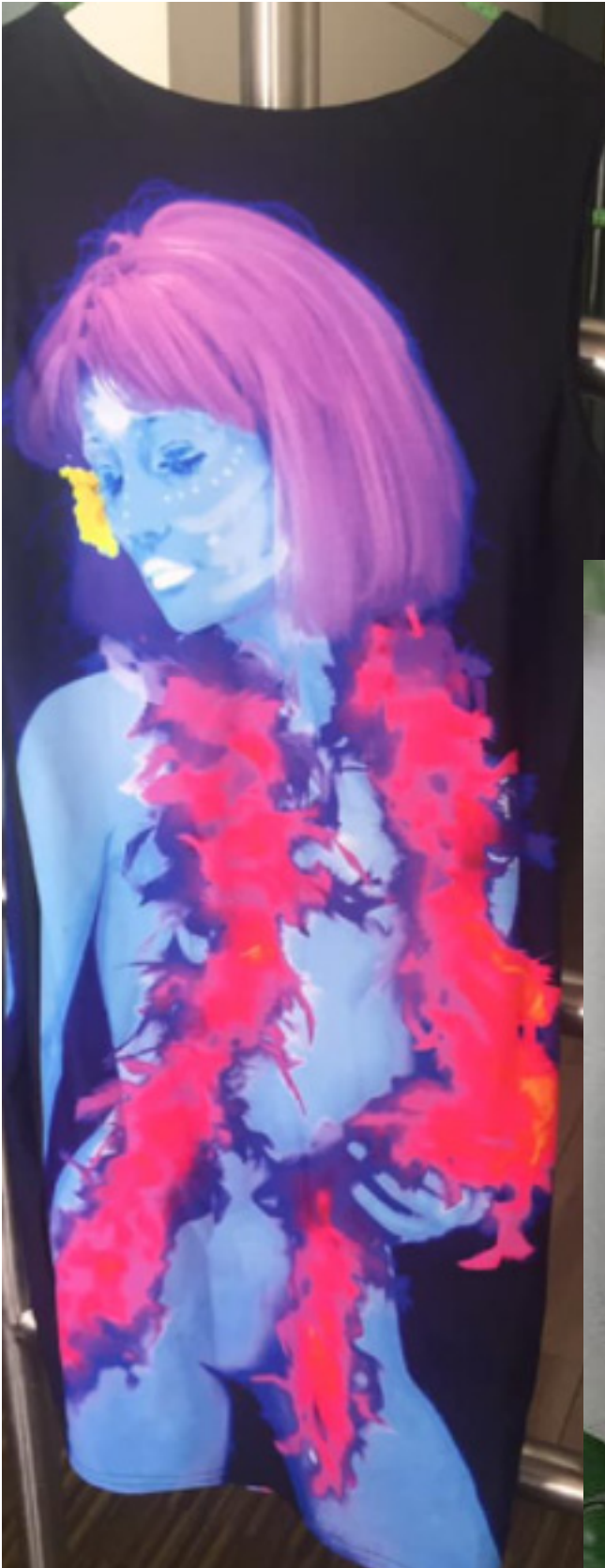

75 neon body paint Glow-Art shoots and has been published more than thirty times in several countries. The process begins with a neon body paint photoshoot. The images are then



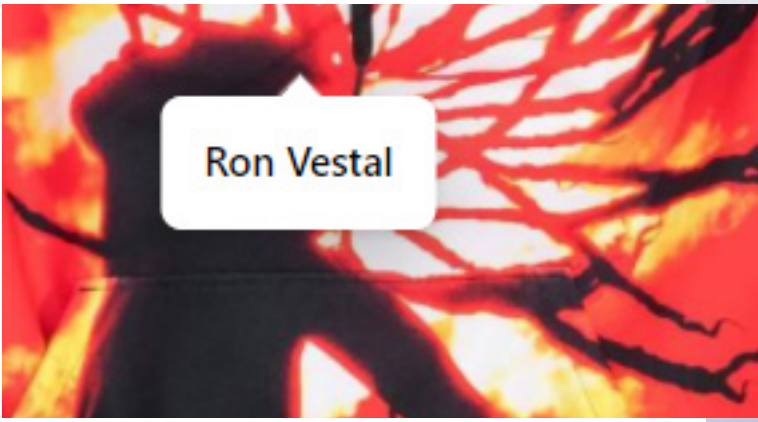
